BCGP employees chose to donate the \$10,000 grant to Halifax Health-Hospice, a leading end-of-life care organization located in southeast Volusia County.

The award was presented to employees of the BCGP facility by Dustan E. McCoy, Brunswick's chairman and chief executive officer, during a formal ceremony on Aug. 12. Those in attendance included Brunswick executives, as well as representatives from Halifax Health Hospice.

“Through generous donations such as this, Halifax Health - Hospice offers programs and services to all patients and families in need,” said Fran Davis, HOVF president and CEO. “No patient or family is denied the necessary resources needed to prepare for the end-of-life journey.
