

BluSkies International LLC P3 Fuel Primer Receives EPA Certification.

BluSkies International, a marine fuel systems technology company, announced today that its P3 outboard motor fuel primer has been issued a certificate of conformity by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The EPA is now regulating marine vessels and this certificate demonstrates that the P3 permeation control technology meets or exceeds emission reduction initiatives that are part of an overall evaporative emissions rule standard implemented by the EPA in October of 2008. The permeation standard set by the EPA for marine primer bulbs is a limit of 15 g/m²/day the P3 has an average emissions level of less than 1 gram.

The P3 fuel primer was the recent recipient of the NMMA's propulsion category at the July 2009 MAATS trade show innovation award and is the very first fuel primer certified by the EPA for use in compliant marine fuel systems, says Mr. Chris Brown the company's president. We look forward to adding more certified components to our fuel system designs going forward and will commercialize them as each phase of the rule is implemented.

BluSkies can be instrumental in helping boat builders cost effectively meet the new EPA evaporative emissions rule standards says Mr. Brown, because our core of competence combines the comprehension of the EPA evaporative emissions rule standards with the ability to apply that knowledge to the design of EPA compliant marine fuel systems, using components designed specifically to operate and function in the most demanding of marine environments.
