In addition to demonstrating five years' marina-management experience, CMM candidates must complete Intermediate and Advanced Marina Management courses available through IMI. The next Intermediate Marina Management course is scheduled for November 14–18, 2010, in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, while the next Advanced Marina Management course is scheduled for March 21–26, 2010 in Charleston, SC.
